10 DAY ITINERARY

'Majani' is the Swahili word for the leaves of trees and between December and March the southern Serengeti literally springs to life with fresh grasses attracting the great migration of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles. This is the time to appreciate the verdant beauty of the savannah, plains and crater with many offroad areas and less visitors generally, you will be spoiled with a high concentration of wildlife and at times feel completely alone in the wilderness.

With our accommodation partners we have created an incredible and authentic 9-night safari tour for the green season to have the best access to the wildlife and to relax in authentic camps with sunsets, cocktails, camp fires, a superb dinner and a good night's sleep; getting ready for the next day's adventure.

DAY 1

- *VIP collection from Kilimanjaro airport*
- *Afternoon Tarangire Game Drive**
- *Arrive at the Simba Tarangire Tented Lodge*
- *Enjoy a drink on the verandah*
- *Dinner*

**Note: This example is for early morning arrivals, for later arrivals we will overnight in Arusha instead before heading off to Tarangire in the morning.*

Tarangire is the perfect place to start any safari with the largest population of elephants with herds sometimes 200-strong. There are also over 700 lions that live permanently in the Tarangire.

The landscape is varied with grasslands and swamps and dotted with the majestic prehistoric Baobab trees and dissected by the Tarangire river.

For the bird-lovers, there are almost 600 species to track down.



DAY 2

- Breakfast in the camp
- Game drive in Tarangire
- Picnic lunch overlooking the Tarangire river
- Return to Simba Lodge
- Take a swim
- Drinks on the verandah
- Gourmet buffet dinner
- Relax around the camp fire

Located near the new Sangaiwe Gate of Tarangire National Park. Tarangire Simba Lodge is situated in a wildlife-rich area with unhampered views to beautiful Lake Burunge, bordered by the park and a Wildlife Management Area. The setting is stunning; with a giant old Baobab tree anchoring one corner and a permeating feeling of real Africa.

In the evening, many animals are attracted to the camp and it is not unusual to see even elephants visiting the pool.



DAY 3

- Game drive in Lake Manyara
- Picnic lunch
- Arrive at Eileen's Tree Lodge
- Go for a swim
- Pre-dinner drinks on the terrace
- Dinner
- Relax on the terrace and firepit

Lake Manyara National Park is one of the smaller parks but very much worth a visit. Starting from the south and exiting in the forest of the Great Rift Valley, we will visit open plains around Lake Manyara to see the hippos.

Lake Manyara is well known for the tree climbing lions, the soda ash lake that attracts thousands of pink flamingos and has one of Tanzania's biggest elephant populations and breath-taking scenery.

The lake is home to over 300 migratory birds long-crested eagles and grey-headed kingfisher.



DAY 4

- Visit the Hadzabe Bushmen
- Visit the Datoga Tribe
- Return to Eileen's Tree Lodge
- Pre-dinner drinks on the terrace
- Dinner
- Relax on the terrace and firepit

The Hadzabe and Datoga tribes offer a fun and wonderful day out to experience the ancient ways of life of tribes that have existed in the region for thousands of years.

Eileen's Tree Inn is in the town of Karatu between the Ngorongoro crater, the Serengeti gateway, and Tarangire and Lake Manyara parks. The lodge is owned and managed by Tanzanians whose mission is to provide safari visitors with good value, comfortable accommodation and an authentic African welcome.

The guest rooms are set in beautiful tropical gardens and you'll find a bar, a small lounge area and a dining room in a rustic wooden building reminiscent of a tree house. The food is wonderful and the experience is entirely African which we think is a great way to start your safari.



DAY 5

- Game drive to Ndutu
- Picnic lunch en route
- Arrive at Tanzania Bush Camp
- Campfire and drinks
- Dinner

The Ndutu area is classic savannah, characterized by flat grassy plains and the place to be to see the migration between December and March.

Tens of thousands of wildebeest, zebra and gazelle usually arrive in December to graze on the newly-watered, highly nutritious short grass plains.

Ndutu is one of the few areas that permit off road venturing giving you total freedom and complete privacy as you track down and explore the wildlife. It offers a great chance to see lionesses and other predator cats with their young cubs.



DAY 6

- Return to Tanzania Bush Camp
- Relax with drinks by the campfire
- Campfire
- Dinner

Tanzania Bush Mobile Camp is situated in Ndutu Big Marsh area, Southern part of the Serengeti ecosystem.

Surrounded by indigenous trees and shrubs which encourage a huge number different birds and mammals to live around the area and away from the busy tourist circuit, Ndutu offers peace and tranquillity far from the crowds.

Here you can relax to the rhythm of an African day as a myriad bird calls herald the rising sun. You can stay close to the camp and enjoy the resident wildlife, or go for a game drive and explore the range of habitats that lie within easy reach. After sunset we return to the homely warmth and hospitality of Tanzania Bush Mobile Camp.



DAY 7

- Arrive at Matawi Tented Camp
- Relax with drinks by the campfire
- Dinner

Meaning ‘endless plains’ in the Maasai language, the Serengeti is undoubtedly one of the world’s most celebrated wilderness areas.

This area is crossed by the thrilling spectacle of the annual migration.

The Central Serengeti also has high-density game-viewing at all times and is well-known for its large concentration of cats, so much so that until recently this area was set aside for scientific research into predators, especially cheetah.

Now is the time to be exploring the rocky kopjes in search of a pride of lions or to find a cheetah with her young cubs.

The Ngorongoro Crater is inside the UNESCO World Heritage Site that is the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. We will first traverse the crater wall, stopping briefly for a breath-taking view of the entire crater before descending into the Ngorongoro Crater which has the highest density of wildlife in Africa.

The Ngorongoro Crater contains the 'big five' of game animals and you have a great chance to see them all.



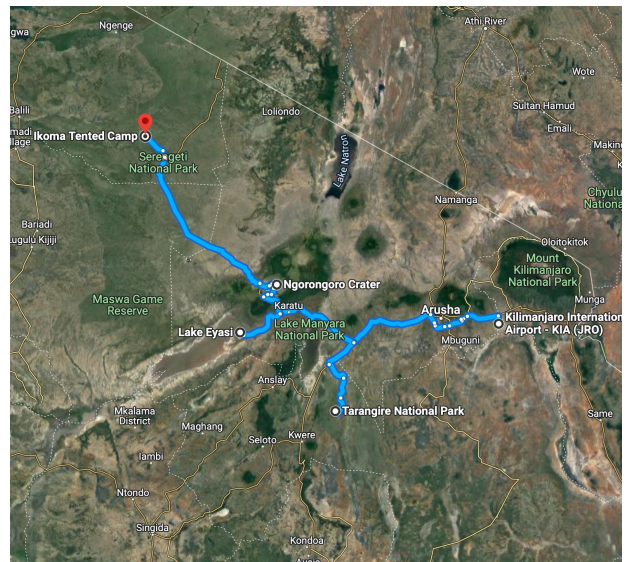
DAY 10
